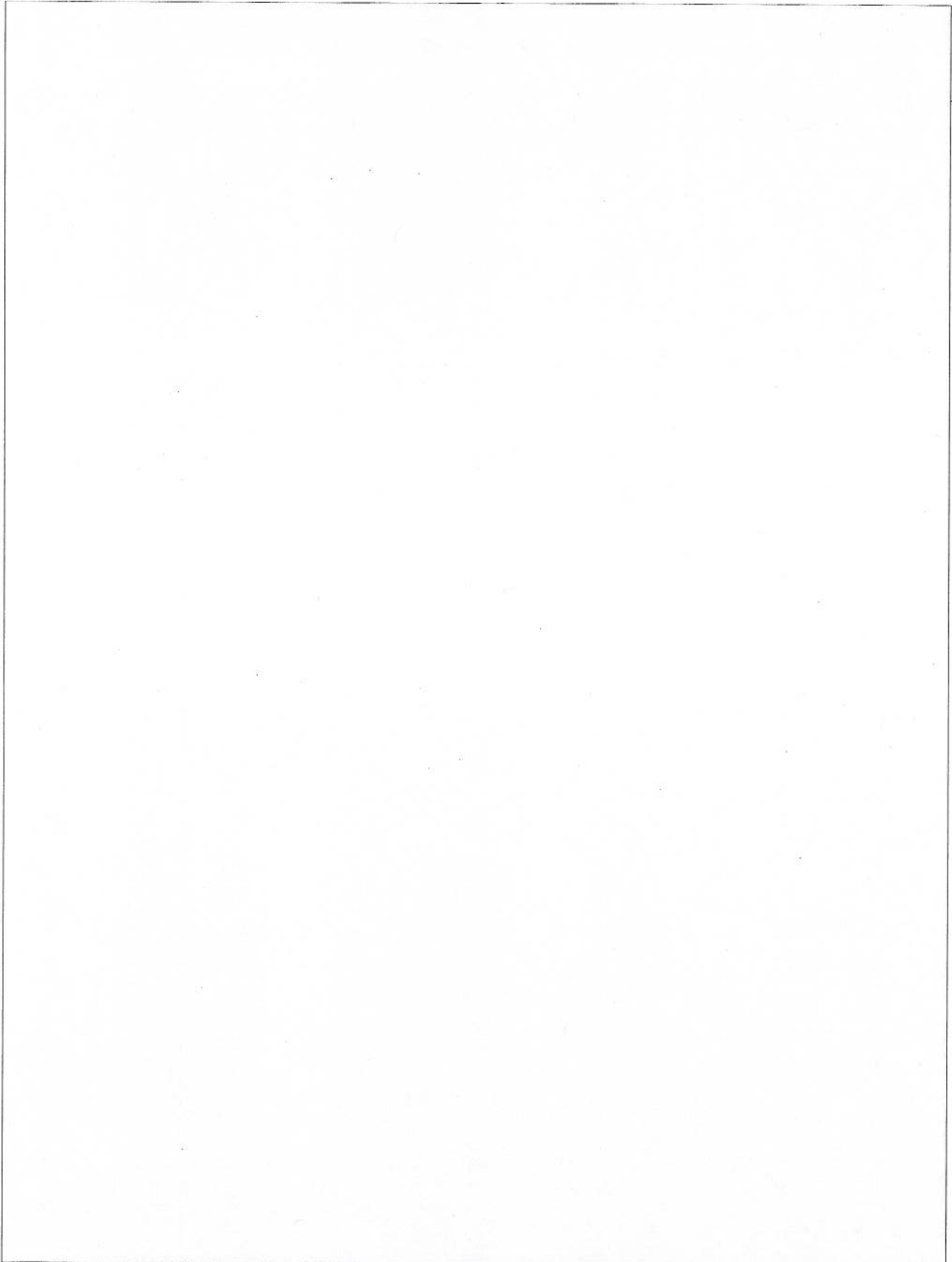

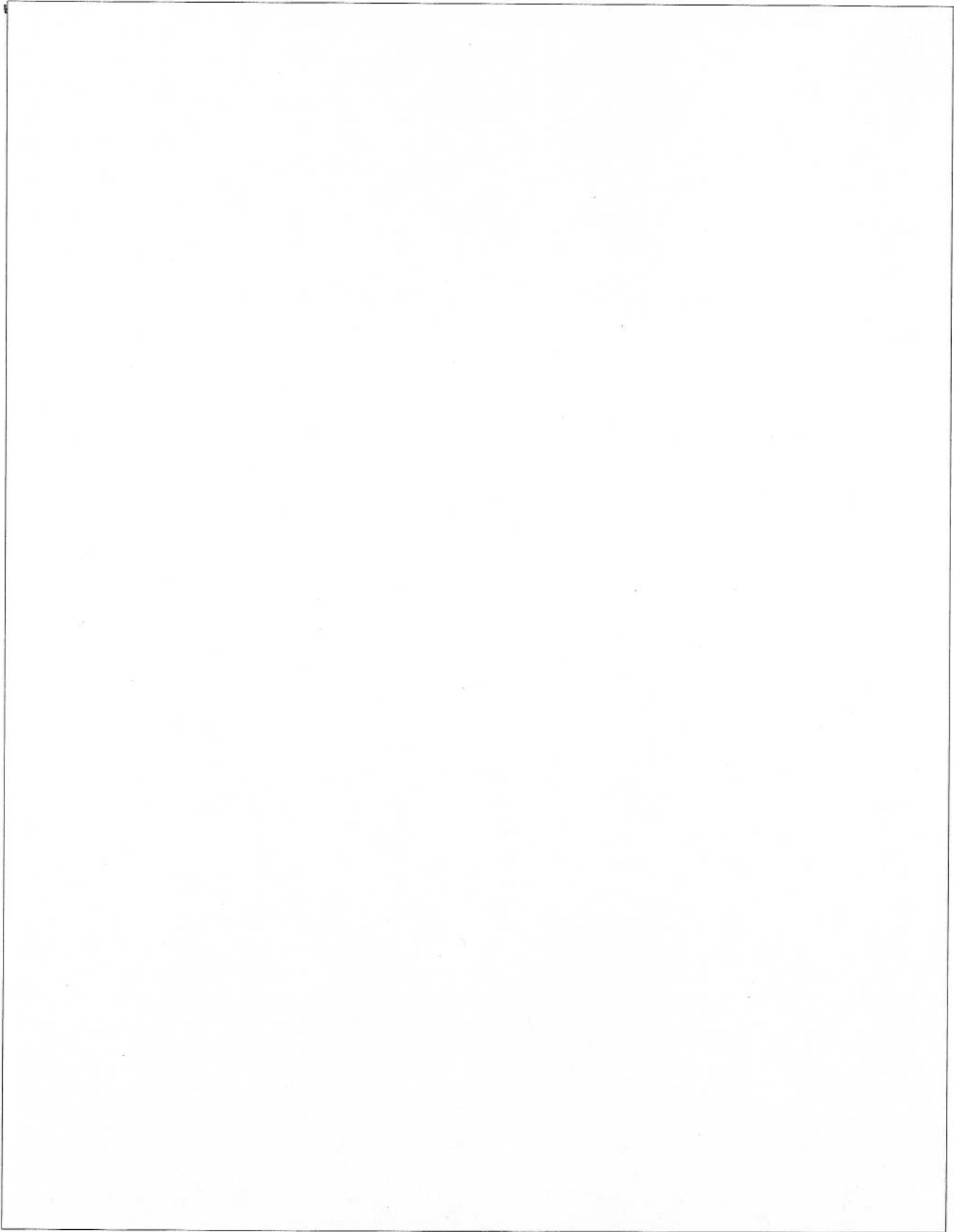

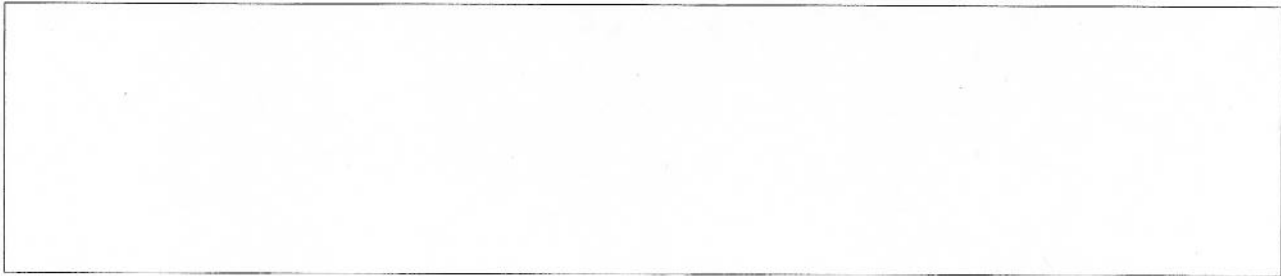

Lillana, thanks for meeting with Tam and me today. I hope you found the conversation useful, and please know if you require further information or clarification at any time. Beyond my thanks, this note also follows up on the two requests that I took away. First, the two environmental audits done in 1992 at cessation of the consortium were performed by: (1) California-based Furgo-McClelland; and, (2) Canada-based HBT Agra. Both audits yielded similar findings.

Secondly, please see attached chart. This demonstrates (1) how the dollars were broken down according to equity ownership (recall that Gulf had equity just in the earliest days of the consortium), and (2) how Texaco's equity share was broken down into dollars that went directly or indirectly to the State, operating/other costs, then finally profit. All of this information was pulled from information that is a matter of public record.

Trust you will share this with your colleagues, as I did not get their contact info. Thanks again for taking the time to meet with us. We are only a phone call away.
